Winemaker Notes

Compared to 2012's growing season, the slightly warmer temperatures in 2013 provided slow, even ripening conditions for maximum flavor development.

Aromas of rhubarb, ripe strawberry and cherry cola greet you, followed by a balance of brown spice, vanilla and clean fresh fruit on the palate. This lighter style Pinot Noir finishes with mild acidity and notes of fresh blackberry.
