Winemaker Notes

We entered 2014 with drought on our minds, but substantial rains in February soon tabled that concern. Moderate temperatures during the growing season reduced the potential for sunburn and raisining, while increasing the fruit's concentration and complexity. We saw great uniformity of berries at harvest. Even heat at the end of August and first part of September helped finish maturity...lot's of fruit came in at same time. This was another earlier than average vintage.

Our 2014 Sauvignon Blanc / Dry Creek Valley welcomes you with lemon blossom, mango, tangerine peel and grapefruit. The round attack is refreshing, with a flavors of citrus blossom, papaya and mango. A crisp lemon-lime finish make this Sauvignon Blanc an incredible partner for shell fish and delicate seafood like sole.
