Winemaker Notes

The 2015 harvest can be described as: dry, early, light, but with exceptional quality fruit. We had less than half the average rainfall for the 2015 growing season, and harvested three weeks earlier, on average, than usual. In a couple of cases we harvested an entire month earlier. Crop loads were down anywhere from 15% to 40%, however the quality of fruit was fantastic. Smaller berries and clusters yielded intense aromatics and flavors. This proved to be a great vintage for fruit characters in all varieties.

Our 2015 Sauvignon Blanc / Dry Creek Valley greets your with tropical aromas of guava, grapefruit and banana. The round balanced attack is refreshing, with flavors of apricot, and clean fresh minerality. A crisp, smooth finish make this Sauvignon Blanc an incredible partner for shell fish and delicate seafood like sole.
