Winemaker Notes

The 2016 harvest was ideal, and very similar to the 2015 season. We began early, and finished early. Unseasonably cool temperatures in mid-September gave a brief respite in what was otherwise a very rapid and consistent harvest season. This proved to be a great vintage for fruit characters in all varieties. Our yields were up slightly from 2015, and the wine quality looks to be spectacular.

Our 2017 Sauvignon Blanc / Dry Creek Valley greets you with tropical aromatics of guava and kiwi, blended with delicate grapefruit blossom and meyer lemon. A fruit driven attack on the palate leads with cantaloupe melon, pear and hints of fresh cut grass. With a medium body and balanced mid-palate weight, notes of slate lead into a refreshingly crisp finish.
