After the challenging 2010 and 2011 vintages, the 2012 growing season was ideal. With perfectly timed early rains, and generally moderate temperatures throughout the growing season, the fruit yield from this vintage was superb.

Our 2012 Zinfandel / Dry Creek Valley welcomes you with aromas of strawberry and almond. The fruit forward attack is smooth and round on the palate, as flavors of cherry and vanilla balance with a touch of bramble spice. Firm tannins and a long finish make this Zinfandel an incredibly versatile food wine.
