Winemaker Notes

The 2015 harvest can be described as: dry, early, light, but with exceptional quality fruit. We had less than half the average rainfall for the 2015 growing season, and harvested three weeks earlier, on average, than usual. In a couple of cases we harvested an entire month earlier. Crop loads were down anywhere from 15% to 40%, however the quality of fruit was fantastic. Smaller berries and clusters yielded intense aromatics and flavors. This proved to be a great vintage for fruit characters in all varieties.

Harvested from the "Front Yard," our Dry Creek Valley Estate Old Vine Zinfandel vines are over 110 years old. Our 2015 Zinfandel / Old Vine / Dry Creek Valley opens with aromas of blackberry pie, fresh lavender, sweet pipe tobacco and nutmeg. A fruit forward attack carries through the smooth mid-palate with notes of plum jam and dried rose petals. Rich and delicious, with great structure that leads into a hint of minerality on the finish. This wine is perfect for summertime barbeques, festive meals with friends.
