## Winemaker Notes

The 2015 harvest can be described as: dry, early, light, but with exceptional quality fruit. We had less than half the average rainfall for the 2015 growing season, and harvested three weeks earlier, on average, than usual. In a couple of cases we harvested an entire month earlier. Crop loads were down anywhere from 15% to 40%, however the quality of fruit was fantastic. Smaller berries and clusters yielded intense aromatics and flavors. This proved to be a great vintage for fruit characters in all varieties.

Our 2015 Chardonnay / Sonoma Coast greets you with beautiful aromas of pear, honey suckle and apple blossom. The bright attack is followed by notes of lemon-lime cream that leads to a crisp, structured finish. This food friendly wine pairs well with a variety of cuisines such as seafood, shellfish, roasted or grilled chicken, and works equally well as a stand-alone wine.
