### Winemaker Notes

The 2016 harvest was ideal, and very similar to the 2015 season. We began early, and finished early. Unseasonably cool temperatures in mid- September gave a brief respite in what was otherwise a very rapid and consistent harvest season. This proved to be a great vintage for fruit characters in all varieties. Our yields were up slightly from 2015, and the wine quality looks to be spectacular.

Aromas of red raspberry, rhubarb, strawberry compote and ripe black cherry greet you, followed by fragrant rose, stemmy tea leaf, spearmint and subtle brown baking spice on the palate. A beautifully rich attack with both a savory and fruit balanced mid-palate weight. This Pinot Noir finishes with notes of lasting black cherry and raspberry tea.
